30(b)(i) and (ii) – free and frank provision of advice or exchange of views

The exemptions in section 30(b) can be applied where disclosure would, or would be likely to, cause substantial inhibition. There must be at least a significant probability that substantial inhibition would occur in order for the exemption to be appropriately applied. There must be a genuine link between disclosure and inhibition: it cannot simply be a remote or hypothetical possibility

We have redacted some statements where colleagues or other persons have given their candid views to inform our thinking. Publishing these would cause substantial inhibition and affect our ability to gather candid views in future to assist in decision-making.
