Remuneration	A description of –
	<ul> <li>(a) remuneration received by virtue of being –</li> </ul>
	• (i) employed or self-employed;
	• (ii) the holder of an office;
	(iii) a director of an undertaking;
	• (iv) a partner in a firm; and
	• (v) involved in undertaking a trade, profession, vocation or any other work;
	• (b) any allowance received in relation to membership of any organisation;



Registerable Interest	Description of Interest
	<ul> <li>(c) the name, and registered name if different, and nature of any applicable employer, self- employment, business, undertaking or organisation;</li> </ul>
	(d) the nature and regularity of the work that is remunerated; and
	• (e) the name of the directorship and the nature of the applicable business.
Undertaking	means: a) a body corporate or partnership; or
	b) an unincorporated association carrying on a trade or business, with or without a view to a profit.
Related Undertakings	A description of a directorship that is not itself remunerated, but is of a company or undertaking which is a parent or subsidiary of a company or undertaking which pays remuneration.
Parent Undertaking	This is an undertaking in relation to another undertaking, a subsidiary undertaking,
	• if a) it holds a majority of the rights in the undertaking; or
	<ul> <li>b) it is a member of the undertaking and has the right to appoint or remove a majority of its board of directors; or</li> </ul>

	• d) it is a councillor of the undertaking and controls alone, pursuant to an agreement with other shareholders or councillors, a majority of the rights in the undertaking.
Contracts	• You have a registerable interest where you have made a contract with the public body of which you are a member:
	<ul> <li>(a) under which goods and services are to be provided to, or works are to be executed for; and</li> </ul>
	• (b) any responsible person has a direct interest, or an indirect interest as a partner, owner or shareholder, director of officer of a business or undertaking, in such goods and services.
	• You must register a description of the contract, including its duration, but excluding the consideration.
Non-Financial Interests	• A description of such interests which may be significant to, of relevance to, or bear upon, the work or operation of Social Security Scotland. It is important that relevant interests such as membership or holding office in other public bodies, clubs, societies and organisations such as trades unions and voluntary organisations, are registered and described.
Group of companies	This has the same meaning as "group" in section 262(1) of the Companies Act 1985. A "group", within s262 (1) of the Companies Act 1985, means a parent undertaking and its subsidiary undertakings.
Houses, Land & Buildings	A description of any rights of ownership or other interests that may be significant to, of relevance to, or bear upon, the work or operation of Social Security Scotland.

Gifts & Hospitality	• You must register the details of any gifts or hospitality received within your current term of office. This record will be available for public inspection. It is not however necessary to record any gifts or hospitality as described in paragraph 3.7 (a) to (c) of the <u>Model Code</u> .
